## **Executive Committee Meeting**

April 13, 2010

### **Minutes**

The Executive Committee of the Edenton Historical Commission met Tuesday, April 13, 2010, at 8:00 a.m. in the Barker House, Edenton, NC. Those in attendance included Chairman Jerry Climer, Vice-Chairman Libby Pope, Treasurer Frank Palm, Secretary Anne Rowe, Commissioners Bob Quinn, Earl Willis, and guests Nancy Nicholls, Director of the Tourism Development Authority and Commission Executive Director Becky Winslow.

Chairman Climer called for a motion to approve the March 23, 2010, minutes. Frank Palm said, "I make a Motion to accept the March 23, 2010 minutes, as presented." Earl Willis seconded the motion, which was unanimously adopted.

Frank Palm stated that Peter Rascoe, a previous Commission Chairman, was instrumental in bringing both Edenton Bell Battery cannons home to Edenton. The cannons, which sit on the lawn of the Barker House, are on short-term loans; one from Shiloh National Park and the other from the Fort Niagara Association. The Commission would like to get both cannons on a permanent basis. In furthering these efforts, Frank moved, "I make a motion to create the Edenton Bell Battery Committee and to name Peter Rascoe as its Chairman." Bob Quinn seconded the motion and the motion was adopted unanimously.

Frank Palm delivered a copy of the Barker House deed given to him by former Commission Chairman John Dowd. A copy will be kept on file in the Barker House and this copy will be placed in the safe deposit box.

There being no further business, Frank Palm motioned to adjourn the meeting. Bob Quinn seconded the motion, which was adopted unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
