

Edenton Historical Commission
Quarterly Commission Meeting
September 30th, 2011
Minutes

The Edenton Historical Commission met Friday, September 30th, 2011, at 4:00 p.m. at Mulberry Hill, Edenton, NC. Secretary Ben Speller called the roll and established that a quorum was present. Those in attendance included Chairman Jerry Climer, Vice-Chairman Libby Pope, Treasurer Frank Palm, Norman Brinkley, Miles Coxe, Susan Creighton, Bill Culpepper, Sambo Dixon, John Dowd, Frances Inglis, Tom Newbern, Ann Perry, Bob Quinn, Earl Willis, Annette Wood, Susan Wood, Linda Eure (Secretary Linda Carlisle's representative to the Commission) and Executive Director Gregg Nathan.
